Learning about your culture is important to us. We like to greet each other in different languages and find out what is important to your family and their values.

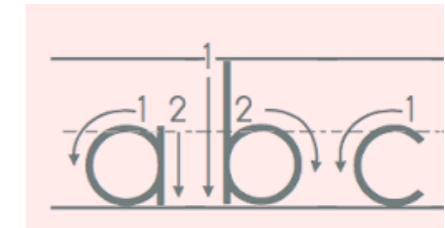
New Entrants Survival Guide
